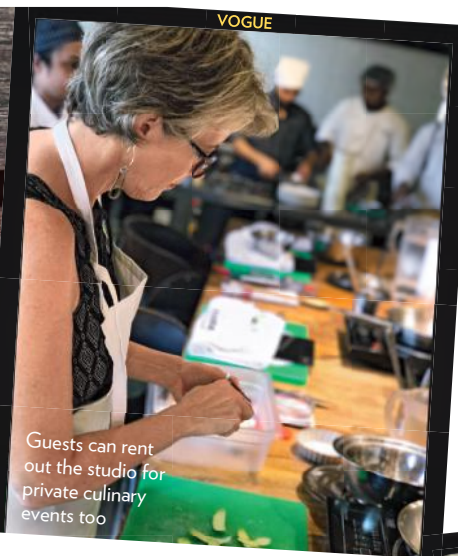


At Roseate House, savour a plate of beetroot and burrata salad for brunch

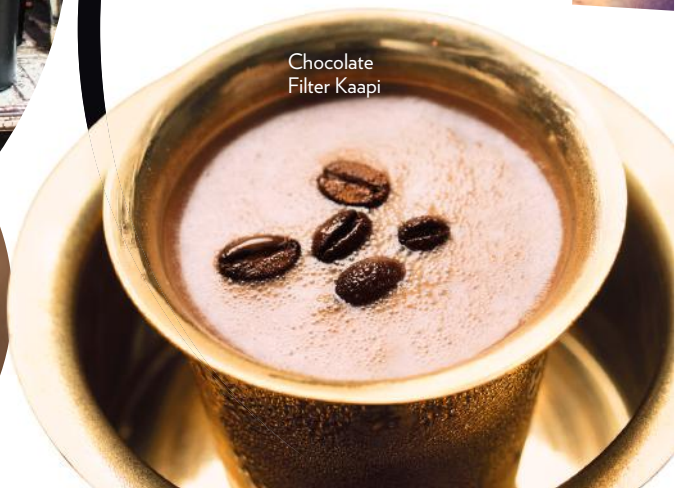
